### **MAJOR CONTRIBUTIONS**








Each dollar of income by an employee in aerospace supports the earning of an additional \$0.90 throughout the Tulsa area economy.

Each dollar of production (value added) in Tulsa-area aerospace supports additionally \$1.10 of gross product throughout the economy.

One year's activity in Tulsa-area aerospace supports total sales tax of \$100.2 million and total property tax of \$54.3 million.





METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA) is a geographical region with a relatively high population density at its core and close economic ties throughout the area. A typical metropolitan area is centered on a single large city that wields substantial influence over the region.
